Notes

- 1 The Club was established on November 4,1996 as a spin-off from the Green River Seniors.
- 2 Officers are elected for a two year term. Elections are held every year at a General meeting held the second Tuesday in August. The President and the Tournament Director are elected in even number years while the remaining officers are elected in odd numbered years. The elected Officers begin their tour of duty on September 1 following their election.
- 3 Roy Womack resigned the Vice Presidency mid-term and Dennis Renk was appointed by President Acselrod to succeed him.
- 4 Due to health issues Pete Haster resigned and was replaced with Steve Oskorus by President Acselrod.
- 5 Because of Dale Pimerton's health issues, Dennis Renk was appointed by President Acselrod to act as the Tournament Director until Dale's return. Dennis also continued to serve as Vice President.

Comment - Unfortunately Dale passed away and never returned.
Dale was one of the five founding fathers (the original board members) of our club.
- 6 Steve Oskorus resigned as Secretary/Treasurer and Lowell Renold was appointed by President Willeford to succeed him.
- 7 Axel Acselrod resigned his position as Handicap Chairman due to medical issues. The position was eliminated due to the reduction in the Club's membership. The Handicap Chairman's responsibilities were reassigned to the Tournament Director. This resulted in the creation of a new office henceforth titled the "Tournament Director and Handicap Chairman".
- 8 President Steve Whitson was killed in a plane crash on June 17, 2009.
- 9 Tom McAllister was voted in for a one year term as President.
- 10 The August membership meeting resulted in the elimination of the Vice-President office by a near unanimous vote (one exception).
- 11 Lowell Renold resigned his position as Secretary/Treasurer due to medical issues. Dan Boyd was appointed by President McAllister to succeed him.
