

The Rules of Golf apply with the following two exceptions:

Butterfield Stage ... Hole #10

The area approximately 100-120 yards from the green:

Our Local Rule, previously in place, allowed for a free drop as it was considered a temporary situation.

This situation is now considered permanent and the area identified by Red stakes is now played as a Hazard.

Sand Traps

Because rakes cannot be used in sand traps, our Local Rule, previously in place, allowed for any ball in the sand trap to be lifted and placed no closer to the green.

This rule has been revised to state "any ball in a sand trap and sitting in a man-made depression (e.g. foot print, divot, etc.) may be lifted and placed no closer to the green".

Note: Winter rules will be in-place beginning December 17
